

Players Committee Role

(Last Updated Feb 2019)

There shall be a Players Committee hereinafter called the committee.

1. Composition of the Players Committee

The Committee shall comprise:

- a. Club President
- b. Men's Captain
- c. Women's Captain
- d. Men's Deputy Captain
- e. Woman's Deputy Captain
- f. Manager and Course Super - Co opted

2. Liaison with the Manager and Course Superintendent, and as directed by the Manager, other Wanaka Golf club Staff

The President is the primary liaison between the Committee and the Manager. In this capacity, the President:

- meets weekly with the Manager;
- ensures that periodic performance reviews of the Players Committee & sub committees conducted with the Manager are undertaken;

Committee Role Description

1. Prime responsibility for the golf game in relation to the men's and women's game and special golf events of the club
2. To perform delegated duties from the Board from time to time
3. To meet regularly
4. The committee may not make any decisions involving a financial commitment by the club unless authorised by the Board
5. To confirm the Club program before going to print in November each year
6. Authorise both match committee and other Players Committee appointed sub committees
7. Compile a game of golf financial budget for Board authorisation before the end of October
8. Liaise with separate Men's and Women's sub committees who shall respectively organise and manage their sections annual programme, matches, pennant competitions and tournament.
9. Liaise with the Manager on the Committees requirements for the Annual Dinner/Prize Presentation
10. To sustain a working relationship with the Clubs Staff Management with recourse to the Board for any resolution of any matter in dispute
11. The committee may offer proposals to the clubs Manager on
 - i. The Players interests on the course
 - ii. House management
 - iii. Development

iv. Other matters relating to the clubs operation

12. The responsibility of course set-up lies with the Players Committee, but the Development Committee can make recommendations regarding Course Set up.

13. The decision on whether to have Placing On is a joint decision between Club Captains (convener of events) and the Rules Convener.
14. To promote and manage the participation of members in club events, Interclub and other competitions
15. To Foster a strong club spirit amongst the members
16. Administrate the rules of play and local rules and to arbitrate and adjudicate and make decisions about the rules of play, taking advice as required from the Rules Convenor.
17. Support the Manager in the promotion of and to promote, membership of the club.
18. Closing the Course is left with the discretion of the Course Superintendant but on club golf event days the Convener of the event needs to liaise with the Course Super and make the decision together. If they are absent, appoint an official to make course closure calls in their absence.
19. Recommendation to the Board of Prize value and entry fee for club events
